Call to Artists: 2015 CVG Show


DEADLINE: November 17, 2014

Jan Lytle moved to approve the Treasurer's report, it was seconded by Mike Clayton and approved unanimously.

Election of Officers

Russel Freeman introduced the sleight of candidates for officers. For President-Maggie Huft, Vice President-Bill Fulton, Secretary -Libby Anderson, and Shar Du Fresne continuing as Treasurer. President Kinley asked if there were any more nominations for officers. There were none. Anita Puzon moved to approve the candidates, motion was seconded by Mike Clayton. The officers were elected unanimously.

Committee Reports

Highway305-Shar Du Fresne reported on the Hwy 305 Building exhibit (Edward Jones).Members will bring art to the November 12 meeting, art will be hung on Friday November 14, and painting taken down on November 14 will be returned November 19.

Reid Realty-Liz Haney reported on the venue at Reid Reality Office. Reid Realty was sold to John L. Scott. So far things will remain the same.

Art by the Bay-Mike Clayton reported on the Art by the Bay. He stated the need for lighter colored canopies to better showcase the art. The current blue canopies are too dark and the art cannot be seen.

Scholarship Report-Liz Haney reported there had been no luck getting in touch with Northwest School of Art. Liz gave a brief history of PAL and the Kitsap Arts & Crafts scholarship collaboration. Inge Matsen discussed the Peninsula Music and Arts scholarship program. Liz will do more research into scholarship options.

Christmas Party-Laura Zetterberg reported the annual Christmas luncheon will be held at the Silverdale Yacht Club Broiler on December 3, starting at 11:30 am. Twenty people have signed up so far.

Old Business

Shar named the people who will be auditing PAL accounts. They are Liz Haney and Diane Clayton.

New Business

Amending By Laws. The proposed changes to the bylaws are to Amend Article VI Fiscal year and Dues to include the definition of the Fiscal year as being from October 1 to September 30, and to

Amend Article IX Duties of Officers from:

(1) As publicity chairman, he/she will prepare all news releases, be responsible for advertising the League's public exhibits, and prepare posters, newspaper articles, etc-.

(2) This officer shall also act as League historian and maintain an accurate scrapbook/photo

album.

(3) This officer shall be responsible for organizing all art shows and public exhibits.

c. The treasurer shall collect all dues and fees, maintain accurate accounts of all receipts and disbursements, disburse funds as authorized by the executive board, and provide written itemized reports of all financial transactions as requested. The financial records shall be audited when requested by the executive board.

d. The secretary shall keep records of all meetings, and have charge of all correspondence, maintain an updated list of all members, and produce and distribute the monthly newsletter.

To the following:

(1) As publicity chairman, he/she will advise and coordinate all news releases, be responsible for advertising the League's public exhibits, and preparation of any required media.

c. The treasurer shall collect all dues and fees, maintain accurate accounts of all receipts and disbursements, disburse funds as authorized by the executive board, and provide written itemized reports of all financial transactions as requested. The financial records shall be audited annually by an auditor selected by the executive board audit committee prior to the annual business meeting.

d. The secretary shall keep records of all meetings, and have charge of all correspondence, maintain an updated list of all members, and produce and distribute the monthly newsletter. The secretary shall also act as League historian and maintain an accurate scrapbook/photo album which may be the club newsletter.

Amend Article X Executive Board Item 4 from:

4. The executive board will ensure the solvency of the Poulsbo Artist League and shall exercise prudence in expenditures of League funds, but will explore all suitable possibilities to meet the purposes and objectives of the organization.

To the following:

4. The executive board will ensure the solvency of the Poulsbo Artist League and shall exercise prudence in expenditures of League funds, but will explore all suitable possibilities to meet the purposes and objectives of the organization. The board will see to an annual audit by an audit team selected by the board. The audit shall be performed in September.

Mike Clayton moved to approve the changes to the bylaws, the motion was seconded by Maggie Huft and the amendments to the bylaws were approved unanimously.

Arts by the Bay-It was suggested to have an artist working on a project by the tent. This has been done in the past and it was very popular. Kathy Piper-Jeffers worked on a Tromp lo lei project this past summer. It will be arranged next year. Procuring a white canopy was discussed. It is a good time to purchase one. Kathy Piper-Jeffers can procure a canopy at discount through her work. Mike Clayton motioned to investigate canopies and set aside fund for two new canopies. Jan Lytle seconded the motion. Motion approved unanimously.
