## *Guidelines for Poulsbo Art Festival Exhibit*

### **Poulsbo Art Festival Exhibit August 20 thru August 22**

Recap ~ See Page 6 of the April 2010 Newsletter Guidelines for Central Market Show.

Sizes: **Art work** to be displayed (Size does not include mat or framing):  
Must be fully framed, glassed or plexi-glassed if WC and wired for hanging.

**One (1) Full Sheet 22"x30" or**  
**Two (2) Half Size Sheet (15"x22") or**  
**Four (4) Quarter 11"x15" or smaller.**

You may bring a second one- if there is room it will be hung.

**Prints** must be shrink-wrapped or plastic-enveloped to be placed in the designated bins.

**Cards** are restricted to 30\* per artist, placed in plastic sleeves and displayed on card racks.

\*Multiple cards contained in same plastic sleeve & sold as a unit is counted as one (1) card.

Art Intake: Wednesday, August 18 – 1:00pm to 3:00pm

Artists will be signed in and assigned a corresponding "Alpha Letter". Artists will be provided labels and log sheets to be completed by the artists.

The intake personnel will assist you with any questions and filling out the removable price labels.

Paintings are to be labeled: (Your Alpha ID ~ Price ~ PT ~ Name of Work ~ Media)

Prints are to be labeled: (Your Alpha ID ~ Price ~ PR )

Cards are to be labeled: (Your Alpha ID ~ Price ~ C )

The removable price labels (stickers) will aid in keeping track of sales.
