Lunch and painting gift exchange -

Date: December 7, 2011

Time: 11:30am to 2 or 3pm (depending on how long you want to stick around)

Location: Hale's Ale House in Silverdale at the Silverdale Mall. There should be plenty of parking at that time of day.

Menu: I hope to have the menu available before the event in a separate mailing.

Gift exchange: This is an optional exchange. Bring a painting and you will take one home. The painting should be an original 5" X 7" - framed for hanging and gift wrapped. Artwork may have a holiday theme, but this is not a requirement.
