Kay's spontaneous "dancing" brushwork and her use of color, wet-into-wet and dry brush techniques result in a realistic floral painting that remains loose and dynamic. Starting with a line drawing and a structural underpainting, Kay takes us step by step through the process of her painting. Learn to capture light on flower petals, add variation and interest in the shadows and leaves as you follow along with Kay's watercolor demonstration. If the paper loses its moist shine, take a dryish brush and blend or feather the paint edges where needed
